

Simple Summer Poncho

Skill Level: Easy

Materials:

Yarn: Lion Brand Yarns - 24/7 Cotton (Medium, #4; 100% Mercerized Cotton; 3.5oz/100g; 186yds/170m) 7 balls.

Crochet Hook: I/9-5.50mm

Gauge before blocking: 12 sc = 4".

Gauge After blocking: 9 sc = 4".

Finished Size: Adult Small. Measuring from point to point from the neckline down it measures approximately 34". Measuring in between the corner points from the neckline down it measures 21.5".

Abbreviations:

Ch/Chs = Chain/Chains

Hdc = [Half Double Crochet](#)

Rep = Repeat

Sc = [Single Crochet](#)

Sk = Skip

Sl St = Slip Stitch

Sp/Sps = Space/Spaces

St/Sts = Stitch/Stitches

Tr = Triple Crochet

Notes:

Mark off corner stitches if needed.

A (tr, ch 1) is worked in between each hdc set, including before and after each corner hdc set.

Turn after each round up to last round. The last round of single crochets is worked from the same side as the last half double crochet round.

Sizing Notes

This pattern is given for the Adult Small, however, you can adjust the size in a multiple of 8 for your starting chains.

Then to establish the four corners for the poncho, divide your number of chains by 4.

Example: $80 \div 4 = 20$. In this case you would mark off every 20th chain as your corner chain. **Note:** To be on the same note as the pattern, place your first marker (for first corner) in the same chain as where you made the join. Then continue to place next three markers evenly around for next three corners.

Then for Rnd 1: work 3 hdc into each marked chain for the corners, and 1 hdc in each unmarked chain.

Then follow pattern and crochet it as long as you like.

You may sell your finished items. The pattern itself, however, is for personal use only.

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Pattern Instructions:

Ch 72, or any multiple of 8; join with sl st in first ch being careful not to twist chs.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, working into [back bumps](#), 3 hdc in same ch as join (first corner hdc set made, place marker in middle hdc of corner set), hdc in next 17 chs, *3 hdc in next ch, hdc in next 17 chs; rep from * around; join with sl st in first hdc. Turn. [80 hdc]

Rnd 2: Sl st into first st, ch 5 (counts as first tr and ch-1 sp, now and throughout pattern), *[sk next st, (tr, ch 1) in next st]; up to corner hdc set, sk next st, (tr, ch 1) 3 times into middle hdc of corner hdc set, (place marker in middle tr to mark corner); rep from * around; join with sl st in first tr (4th ch). Turn. [48 ch-1 sps]

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 hdc in first ch-1 sp (first hdc set made), 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, *3 hdc in corner tr, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp and into each ch-1 sp up to corner tr; rep from * around ending last rep when you get back to first hdc set; join with sl st in first hdc. Turn. [108 hdc]

Rnd 4: Ch 5, (tr, ch 1) in between next hdc set and in between each hdc set to corner hdc set; *sk next hdc, (tr, ch 1) 3 times into next hdc, (tr, ch 1) before next hdc set and in between each hdc set to corner; rep from * around ending last rep when you get back to first tr; join with sl st in first tr (4th ch). Turn. [64 ch-1 sps]

Rnd 5: Ch 1, 2 hdc in first ch-1 sp and into each ch-1 sp up to corner tr, *3 hdc

in corner tr, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp and into each ch-1 sp up to corner tr; rep from * around ending last rep when you get back to first hdc set; join with sl st in first hdc. Turn. [140 hdc]

Rnds 6-29: Rep Rnds 4 and 5 until desired length, omitting last turn at last rnd.

Last Rnd: Ch 1, sc in first st and into each st around working 3 sc into each corner. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten Off.

Super Saver Poncho



The Super Saver Poncho was worked in the same pattern as above, starting with 72 chains, for 20 rounds total.

Yarn: Red Heart Super Saver Ombre (Worsted Weight (#4) 100% acrylic, 10 oz/283g – 482 yds/440m) 1 ball for poncho as shown.

Crochet Hook: I/9-5.50mm

Gauge: 11 sc = 4".

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Finished Size: Adult XS/Teen.

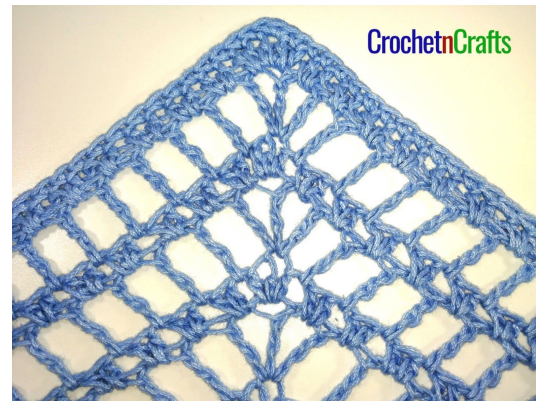
Measuring from point to point from the neckline down it measures approximately 17". Measuring in between the corner points from the neckline down it measures 12.5".

Baby Poncho - 6 months.



set made, place marker in middle hdc of corner set), hdc in next 9 chs, *3 hdc in next ch, hdc in next 9 chs; rep from * around; join with sl st in first hdc. Turn. [48 hdc]

Then follow pattern from Rnd 2 for up to 8 rounds as shown.



Yarn: Lion Brand Yarns - 24/7 Cotton (Medium, #4; 100% Mercerized Cotton; 3.5oz/100g; 186yds/170m) 1 ball.

Crochet Hook: I/9-5.50mm

Gauge before blocking: 12 sc = 4".

Gauge After blocking: 9 sc = 4"

Warning: Do not leave babies unattended while wearing this poncho. It has large holes for the baby to become entangled in.
