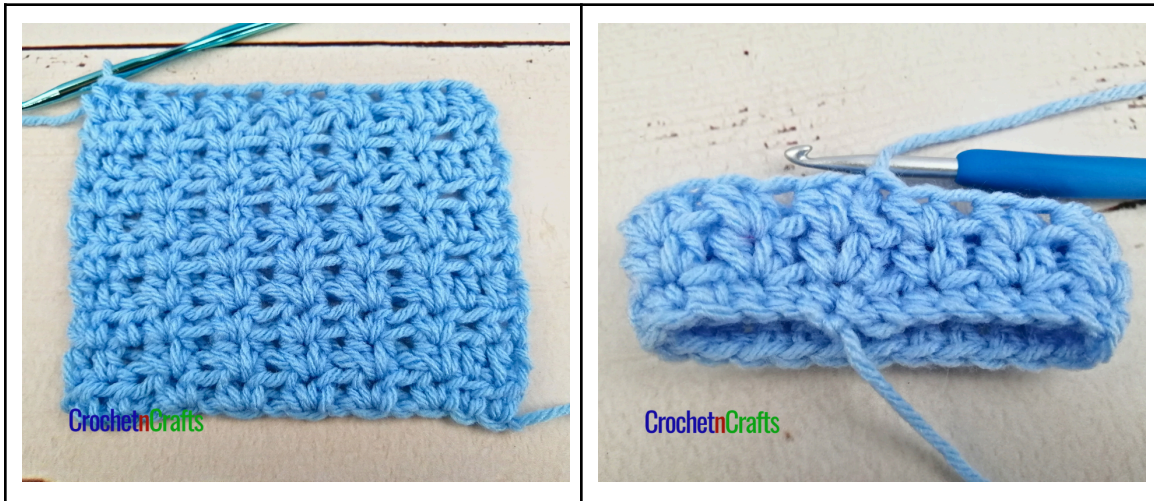


Closed Half Double Crochet V-Stitch

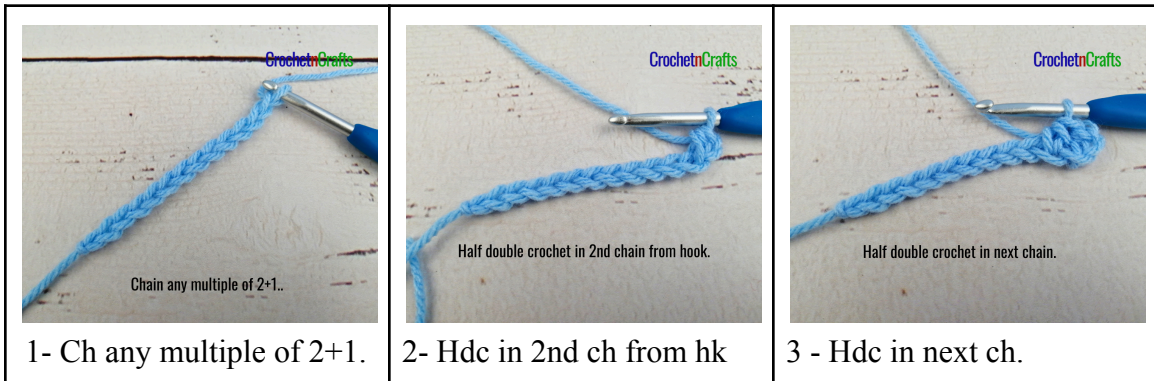

The closed half double crochet v-stitch is made with 2 half double crochet stitches in the same chain, stitch, or space. Use a larger hook to bring out a pretty lacy texture.

To work one v-stitch into another, place your hook in the space between the 2 half double crochet stitches that make up the v-stitch in the previous row/round.

 <p>2 half double crochet in next chain. These 2 half double crochets count as the first v-stitch.</p> <p>Skip 1 chain.</p>	 <p>Continue to skip 1 chain, v-stitch into next chain until you get to the last 2 chains.</p>	 <p>Half double crochet into last 2 chains. Turn.</p>
<p>4 - Sk 1 ch, 2 hdc in next ch. (These 2 hdc make the first v-st).</p>	<p>5 - Continue across: Sk 1 ch, v-st in next ch until you get to last 2 chs.</p>	<p>6 - Hdc in last 2 chs. Turn.</p>
 <p>Chain 1. Half double crochet into first 2 stitches.</p>	 <p>V-stitch into next v-stitch.</p>	 <p>V-stitch into each v-stitch across.</p>
<p>7 - *Ch 1. hdc in first 2 sts.</p>	<p>8 - V-st in next v-st.</p>	<p>9 - V-st in each v-st across.</p>
 <p>Half double crochet into the last 2 stitches.</p>		
<p>10 - Hdc in last 2 sts. Turn. Repeat from * to do more rows.</p>







Working in Rounds

 <p>Make your foundation in any multiple of 2.</p>	 <p>Ch 1, work 2 hdc into the same st as where join was made. The 2 hdc count as the first v-st.</p>	 <p>Sk next st. 2 hdc in next st.</p>
<p>1 - Ch any multiple of 2. Join. I worked a round of sc, but you don't have to.</p>	<p>2 - Ch 1, 2 hdc in same st as join. The 2 hdc count as your first v-st.</p>	<p>3 - Sk next st, v-st into the next st.</p>
 <p>Repeat around. Sk last st.</p>	 <p>Join the round keeping the joining sl st loose to resemble a st.</p>	 <p>Sl st into the sp before next st (into the first v-st)</p>
<p>4 - Repeat around: sk next st, v-st in next st. Sk the last st.</p>	<p>5 - Join the round loosely with a slip stitch.</p>	<p>6 - Sl st into the sp before next hdc (into the v-st st).</p>
 <p>Ch 1, v-st into the same v-st.</p>	 <p>V-st into each v-st.</p>	
<p>7 - Ch 1, v-st into same v-st.</p>	<p>8 - V-st into the next v-st and into each v-st around.</p>
